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## Floor and Wall Tiling FETAC Level 3, 3N0523

**Programme Aim:** This programme has been designed to help enable participants to develop the knowledge and skills necessary to prepare, plan and complete a range of tiling activities correctly understanding different methods, reasons and designs used in the industry. Participants will learn to correctly measure an area, design tiling patterns, complete cutting, fixing, laying and finishing techniques used by professionals while using the correct tools and techniques. This programme will ensure that participants understand all safety measures involved in this activity to maintain adherence to current legislation.

### Participants of this programme will:

- Understand tools and materials used in tiling activities
- Measure area correctly to estimate cost of a project
- Design and identify a number of tiling patterns
- Prepare an area for tiling
- Be capable of cutting, fixing and laying tiles correctly
- Understand how to complete grouting on laid tiles
- Know how to correctly clean an area after tiling has been completed
- Understand safety requirements associated with tiling activities and possible threats that could cause harm.

### Programme Content

- Select materials and tools required to complete a range of tiling activities
- Understand relevant tools and techniques used by professionals to tile an area.
- Prepare an area of tiling, complete cutting, fix and lay tiles
- Grouting and cleaning area after project completed
- Follow designs and patterns while laying tiles
- Understand relevant health and safety legislation

<b>Programme level</b>	This programme leads to a Level 3 on the National Framework of Qualifications
<b>Progression and Credit Value</b>	Any Major Award associated with construction site/maintenance award, this programme is worth 5 Credits towards the above major award
<b>Duration</b>	This programme will run for 3-4 contact days depending on the project and will require participants to complete some work in their own time
<b>Who should attend this course</b>	People seeking skills in or are looking to gain formal qualification in Tiling or Maintenance positions
<b>Required fluency in generic skills</b>	Generally learners engaging in learning activities leading to level 3 awards are ready to take on a new task in personal capacity or role. Learners can follow direction and are moving towards independent learning. Learners will have the ability to read basic short text in a non-supported environment and will be able to make sense of quantitative information within a familiar setting or unfamiliar task in a familiar setting.
<b>FETAC Assessment</b>	Participants who wish to achieve a FETAC Component Certificate must complete 100% Skills Demonstration
<b>Resources Required in Order to Successfully Complete the Module</b>	Some personal learning / study time will be required from participants. Programme packs, Assessment Briefs and some equipment will be provided as a part of the programme
<b>Specific Entry/Access &amp; Exemptions required</b>	Access to programmes leading to level 3 is open. A learner seeking entry to a programme leading to awards at level 3 does not need a previous formal qualification. Some Learners may have achieved certification at level 2.

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
