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Home Repair and Maintenance 4N3774

Programme Aim: to provide learners with the opportunity to develop the knowledge, skills and competencies necessary to understand hazards associated when completing a range of home repair and maintenance tasks. On completion participants should be capable of carrying out plumbing tasks associated with water mains and storage, Understand cables used in domestic wiring, will be able to fit plugs and wire socket outlets, light switches and light fittings. Complete a range of tiling activities including measuring, cutting, fixing and grouting of tiling and completing domestic painting activities correctly while adhering to relevant legislation.

Participants of this programme will:

- Understand tools and materials used in Home Repair and Maintenance
- Be familiar with safety legislation surrounding this area and possible hazards
- Be able to complete a range of plumbing activities associated with toilets, sinks, radiators and water storage equipment
- Carry out electrical maintenance
- Prepare an area for painting and apply paint correctly
- Fix Plasterboards and apply bonding and skim coat
- Understand how to measure, price, cut, fix and grout tiling area
- Show care for maintenance of tools and equipment

Programme Content

- Health and Safety to include the correct use of materials, responsibility and common hazards and symbols
- Complete a range of domestic plumbing activities which include identifying fittings and materials, making joins, cutting or bending of pipes, fitting or replacing and repairing and installing of materials
- Carry out a tiling project including measuring, preparation, cutting and fixing tiles to a wall or floor and grouting
- Identification of cable use for domestic wiring, fit and connect a socket outlet, light switch and fittings, wire a plug.
- Prepare an area for painting, assess colour wheel and complete a painting project

Duration	This programme will run for 6-7 contact days depending on the project and will require participants to complete some work in their own time
Who should attend this course	People seeking skills in or are looking to gain formal qualification in Maintenance or Repair
Required fluency in generic skills	Learners entering programmes leading to awards at level 4 will usually be comfortable reading, drafting, preparing and understanding personally relevant information, including quantitative information. Learners will also be capable of solving familiar problems well, independently and as part of a group
FETAC Assessment	Participants who wish to achieve a FETAC Component Certificate must complete 60% Project and 40% Learner Record
Resources Required in Order to Successfully Complete the Module	Some personal learning / study time will be required from participants. Programme packs, Assessment Briefs and some equipment will be provided as a part of the programme
Specific Entry/Access & Exemptions required	A learner seeking entry to a programme leading to awards at level 4 does not need a previous formal qualification. Some learners may have achieved some certification at level 3 and we would recommend they have life or work experience within the chosen programme sector

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
