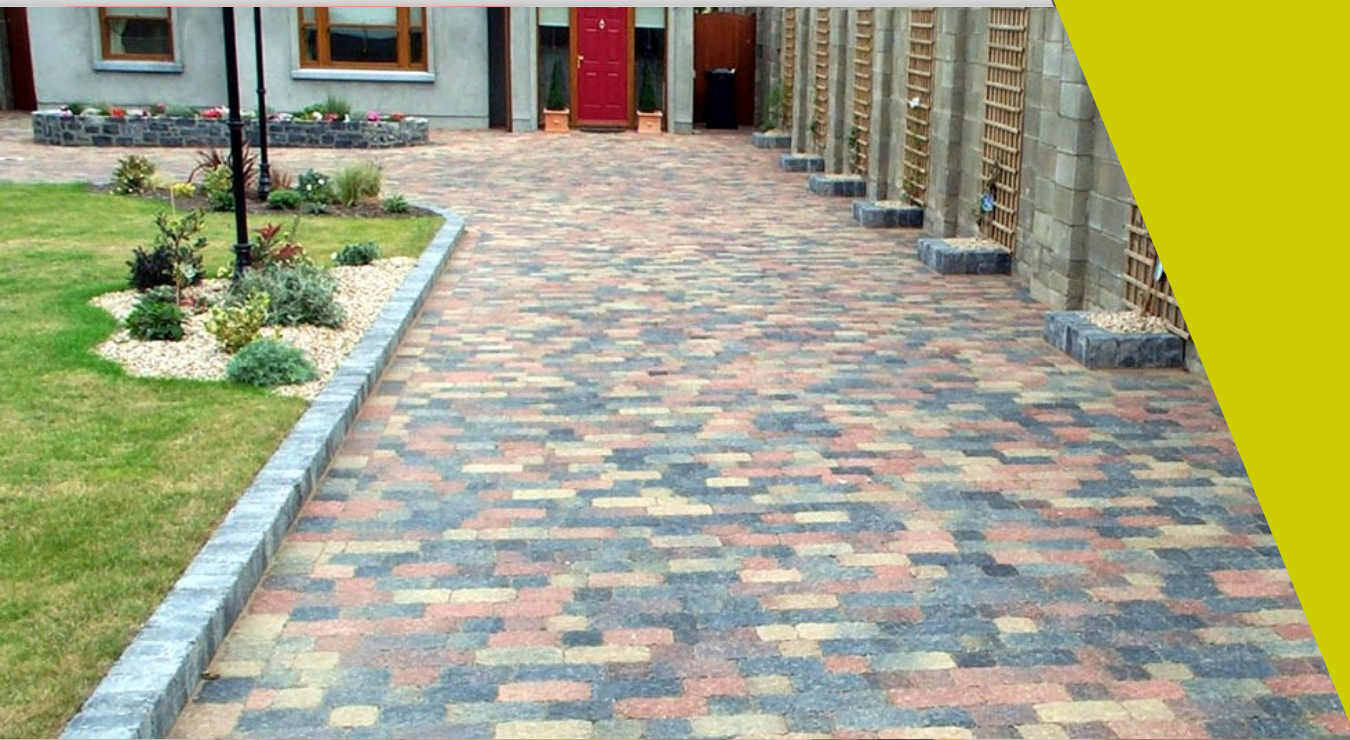

Programme Aim: This programme has been designed to enable participants to develop the knowledge and skills necessary to be capable and investigating the key issues of health and safety regarding the hazards of laying kerbs, flags and paviers and be able to demonstrate the correct method required to lay them correctly ensuring no harms to them or others. On Completion participants will be able to identify the correct bed thickness and strength required for various loads and weight of traffic passing over the paved area, have the correct skills to lay them correctly using various paving patterns and to learn a range of finishing techniques used in this sector of work

Participants of this programme will:

- Provide costing and estimations for job completion
- Design suitable patterns for area
- Understand health and safety requirements for laying kerbs, flags and patios
- Use the correct protective equipment
- Prepare the area correctly avoiding sink age or uneven surfaces
- Understand and be capable of completing base requirement to a high standard
- Lay patio correcting with correct cutting and jointing techniques
- Complete finishes suitable for the various tasks required

Programme Content

- Methods for fitting kerbs around paved areas
- Paving Patterns
- Falls and Transfer levels from drawings
- Topsoil and vegetation removal
- Jointing kerbs and garden edges

- Sand and cement mixes for finishes

Programme level	This programme leads to a Level 4 on the National Framework of Qualifications
Progression and Credit Value	This programme can be used towards a special, purpose awards in Construction Ground Work Skills 10 Credits towards a major award
Duration	This programme will run for 5 or 6 contact days depending on the project and will require participants to complete some work in their own time
Who should attend this course	People seeking skills in or are looking to gain formal qualification in Laying Kerbs, Flags and Paviers
Required fluency in generic skills	Learners entering programmes leading to awards at level 4 will usually be comfortable reading, drafting, preparing and understanding personally relevant information, including quantitative information. Learner will also be capable of solving familiar problems well, independently and as part of a group
QQI Assessment	Participants who wish to achieve a QQI Component Certificate must complete 70% Project and 30% Examination
Resources Required in Order to Successfully Complete the Module	Some personal learning / study time will be required from participants. Programme packs, Assessment Briefs and some equipment will be provided as a part of the programme
Specific Entry/Access & Exemptions required	A learner seeking entry to a programme leading to awards at level 4 does not need a previous formal qualification. Some learners may have achieved some certification at level 3 and we would recommend they have life or work experience within the chosen programme sector

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
