## FAR: First Aid Responders

The aim of this programme is to enable the participants to respond to emergencies in a pre hospital environment. The participant will explore assessment and management of different illnesses and injuries until the emergency medical team arrive. First Aid Responders must be able to demonstrate a commitment to the process of continuous responder competence.

### Participants of this programme will:

- Recognise and Assess the causes and effects of sudden illness and injury in a prehospital environment
- React to such pre-hospital emergencies
- Respond in a safe, effective, and appropriate manner to such emergencies utilising the First Aid Response skill set
- Record and Report incidents appropriately when handing over to medical teams
