Programme Aim: This programme has been designed to help enable participants to develop the knowledge and skills necessary to practically provide treatment for the purpose of preserving life or minimising injury and coordinate 1st Aid to include cardiac first responders training in automated external defibrillators (AEDs) and administering aspirin to patients while adhering to compliance with current legislation until the arrival of medical assistance. Our Occupational First Aid Certificates comply with the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work Act (General Applications 2007 (SI No. 299/2007). Participants will be required to attend a refresher after 2 years of completion of this programme.

Participants of this programme will:

- Understand the responsibilities of the occupational first aider
- Be familiar with health and safety legislation on first aid provision in the workplace
- Be able to provide treatment for preserving life or minimising the consequences of injury until the arrival of medical aid
- Be able to provide treatment in the workplace for an injury which does not require the attention of a medical practitioner or nurse
- Be capable of coordinating first aid arrangements in the workplace
- Be registered as Occupational First Aiders with QQI certification
- Demonstrate up-to-date practical skills
- Explain new developments in First Aid.

Programme Content

- First aid in the workplace
- Patient assessment
- Respiratory emergencies
- Cardiac first response
- Wounds and bleeding
- Altered levels of consciousness
- Musculoskeletal injuries
- Burns and scalds, chemicals, electric shock.

Programme level	This programme leads to a Level 5 on the National Framework of Qualifications
Progression and Credit Value	Any Major Award. This programme is worth 1 Credit of 8 to achieve a Major Award
Duration	This programme will run for 3 contact days depending on the project and will require participants to complete some work in their own time
Who should attend this course	People seeking skills in or are looking to gain formal qualification as an Occupational 1st Aider
Required fluency in generic skills	Learners entering a programme leading towards an award at Level 5 will usually be proficient at reading, drafting, preparing and understanding information across a broad range of topics, including quantitative information. Learners may solve predicable problems well, independently and as part of a group. Learners participate well in a chosen area of expertise, using a range of tools and procedures, responsibly and autonomously.
QQI Assessment	Participants who wish to achieve a QQI Component Certificate must complete 80% Skills Demonstration and 20% Exam
Resources Required in Order to Successfully Complete the Module	Some personal learning / study time will be required from participants. Programme packs, Assessment Briefs and some equipment will be provided as a part of the programme
Specific Entry/Access & Exemptions required	A learner seeking entry to a programme leading to awards at level 5 does not need a previous formal qualification. HCT would highly recommend that that learners have achieved some certification at Level 4 or have relevant work/ life experience
