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Safety & Health at Work 5N1794

Programme Aim: to equip learners with the knowledge, skill and competency to achieve a QQI Level 5 in Safety & Health at Work 5N1794. Our trainers are highly qualified with a vast background of experience, are educated to degree level and hold a training qualification. There will be a particular emphasis on the learner maintaining safety & health in a work environment. They should be able to identify challenges and be able to comfortably solve them, both independently and within a group. Progression for successful learners will be to other programmes leading to other certificates where this component is mandatory or an elective requirement.

Participants of this programme will:

- Understand Health and Safety Legislation including, Safety, Health and Welfare at Work 2005, General Application Regulation 2007 and the role of the HSA
- Be able to understand and comply with safety statements and risk assessment
- Identify hazards in the work environment, evaluate them, develop control measures, record and review
- Implement Fire safety in relation to prevention methods and actions
- Understand environmental factors including noise, sound, PPE and dust
- Be able to investigate accidents and report them

Programme Content

- Understand the role of the HSA and current legislation that effect employees and employers
- Be capable of completing risk assessments and completing action points and control measure
- Accident investigation and reporting to include causes, prevention emergency procedures, reporting and record
- Understand and investigate safety statements and safety manuals
- Health and Safety management measures
- Fire hazards, their source and the requirement for the fire prevention controls

Progression and Credit Value	Any Major Award. This programme is worth 15 Credit of 120 to achieve a Major Award,
Duration	This programme will run for 5 contact days depending on the project and will require participants to complete some work in their own time
Who should attend this course	People seeking skills in or are looking to gain formal qualification in Health and Safety in the Work place
Required fluency in generic skills	Learners entering programme leading towards at Level 5 will usually be proficient at reading, drafting, preparing and understanding information across a broad range of topics, including quantitative information. Learner may solve predicable problems well, independently and as part of a group. Learners participate well in a chosen area of expertise, using a range of tools and procedures, responsibly and autonomously.
QQI Assessment	Participants who wish to achieve a QQI Component Certificate must complete 60% Skills Demonstration and 40% Exam
Resources Required in Order to Successfully Complete the Module	Some personal learning / study time will be required from participants. Programme packs, Assessment Briefs and some equipment will be provided as a part of the programme
Specific Entry/Access & Exemptions required	A learning seeking entry to a programme leading to awards at level 5 does not need a previous formal qualification. HCT would highly recommend that that learners have achieved some certification at Level 4 or have relevant work/ life experience

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
